

# Brain Pop

## What is BrainPOP?

1. It is a web site that features Math, English, Science, Social Studies, Health, and Technology topics for grades K – 8.
2. It was developed according to national standards (NCTM, NSES, & NCTE), with hundreds of topics that present students with an engaging, enlightening, and entertaining view of a given subject.
3. Combine each topic with a 2-4 minute **animated movie**, along with various features such as **interactive quizzes, experiments, timelines, how-to segments, comic strips**, and **printable activity pages** to help present the subject.
4. BrainPOP, BrainPOP, Jr., and BrainPOP ESL can be found on the teacher Software-Password chart.
5. Choose a subject or use the **Search** feature to locate specific topics.
6. **For a Complete List of Topics** to visit <http://www.brainpop.com/topics/> or choose the link from the bottom of the **BrainPOP** screen.
7. Teachers should direct BrainPOP student activities.
8. Some movies may not be appropriate for your particular age students (for example: Health topics that include subjects such as puberty and reproduction).
9. Direct students to specific choices that include topics on current courses of study rather than allowing free choice in BrainPOP.
10. *As always* previewing topics before directing your students to them is strongly recommended.
11. *BrainPOP is available to students during school hours.*
12. *A “teacher only” password is available for teacher after hours use and is located on the Software-Password list.*
