# Introduction

- In February 2008, New South Research conducted an online survey of parents with children in the Mountain Brook Schools. The primary objective of the survey was to evaluate the level of satisfaction of parents with their children’s educational experience.
- In total, 904 families were invited by email to participate in the survey. The parents were initially contacted by the Superintendent, Dr. Mason, and were then invited to participate by New South Research. Those who had not responded after two days were reminded about the survey in a second email, and the parents were sent a final reminder two days before the survey closed. Out of the 904 families that were contacted, 610 completed the survey giving the study a 67% response rate. The number of responses for each school is as follows:

– Brookwood Forest Elementary	97
– Crestline Elementary	113
– Cherokee Bend Elementary	81
– Mountain Brook Elementary	100
– Mountain Brook Junior High	215
– Mountain Brook High School	203
- A total of 610 surveys were conducted. Based on a sample of this size, the statistical margin of error is 3.4 percentage points at the 95% confidence interval. That is, the results will vary by no more than +/-3.4 percentage points from the results in this report 95 times out of 100.
- Some tables presented within this report may not add up to exactly 100% because of rounding or omission of non-pertinent data.

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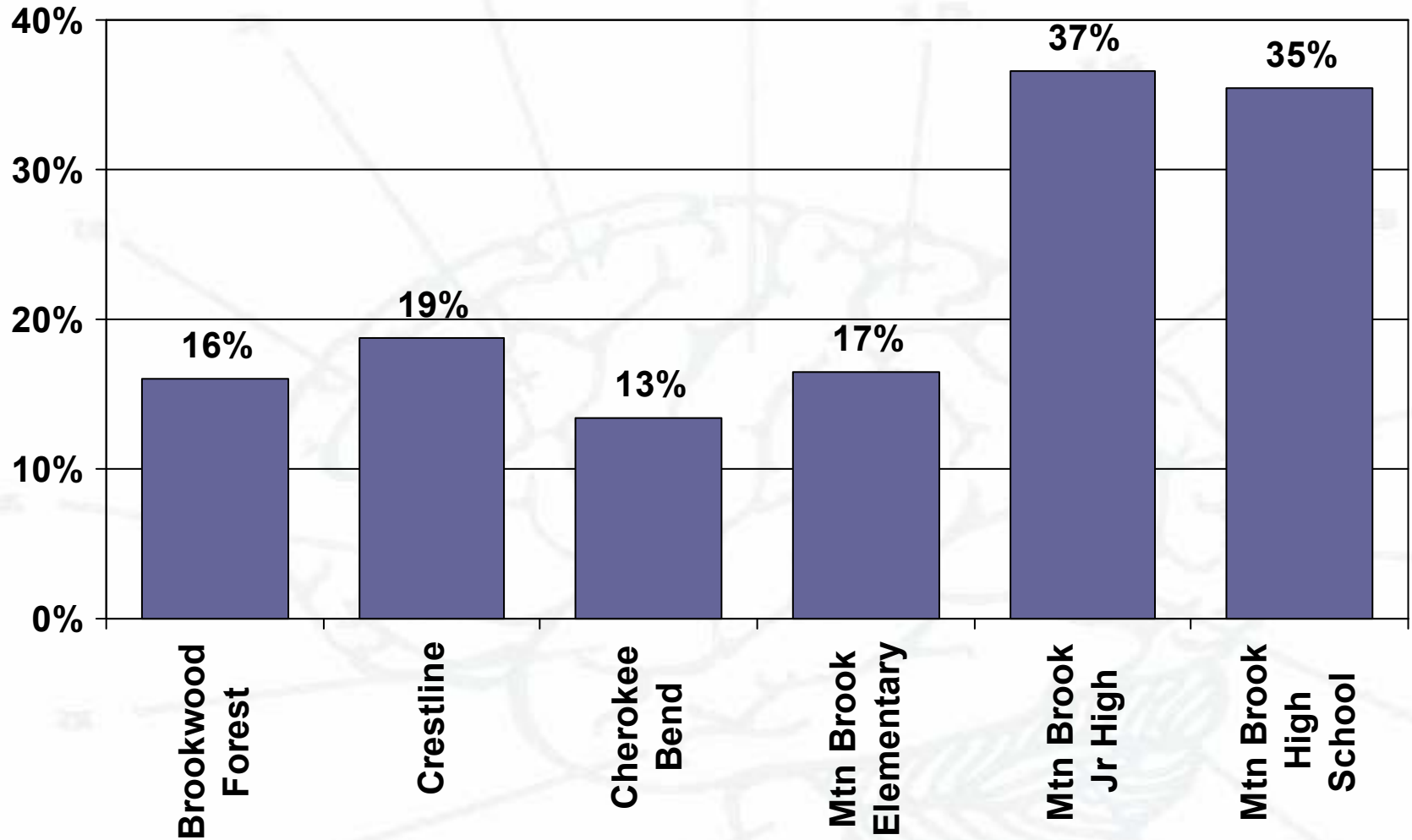

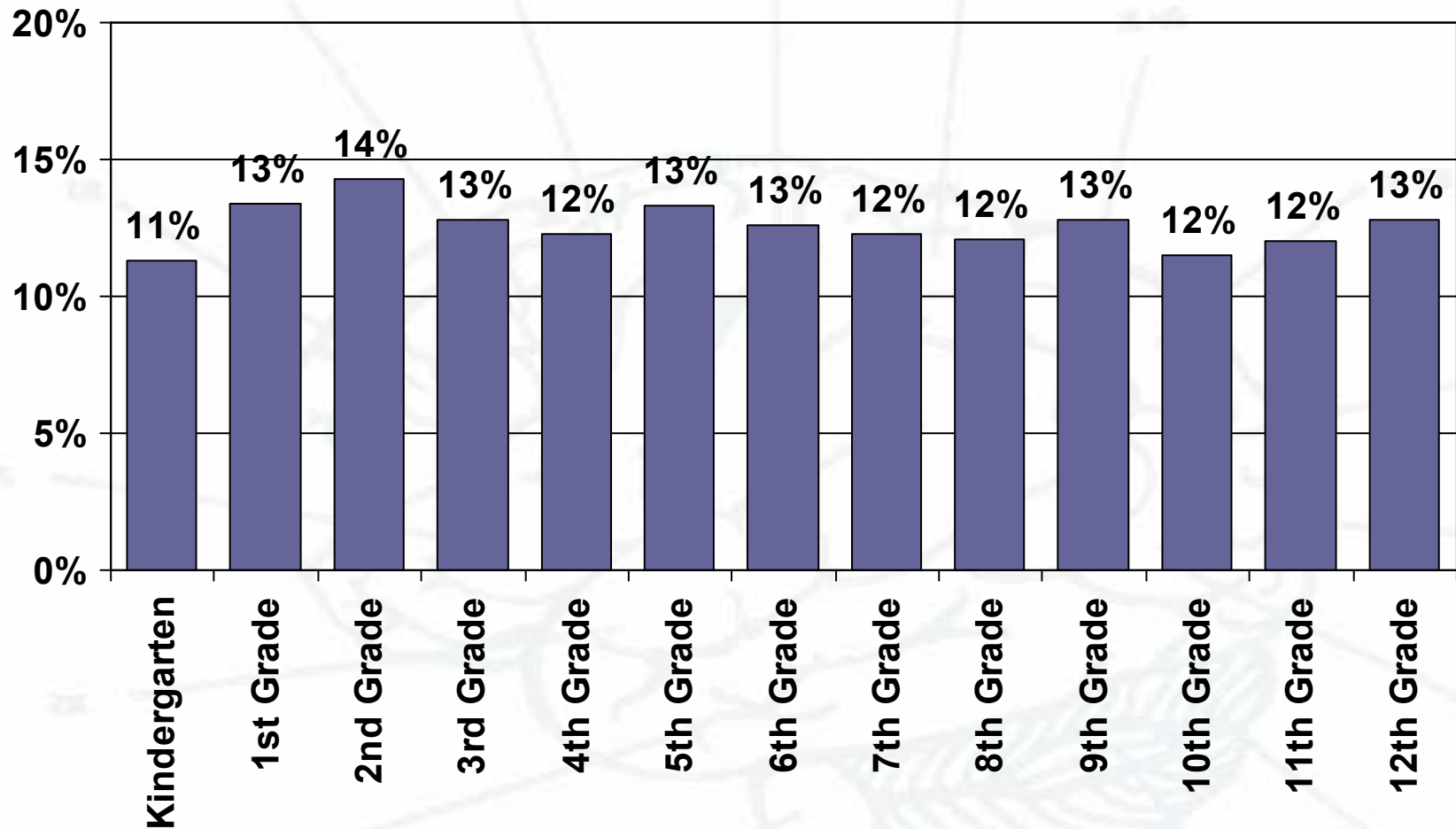
# Overall, what grade would you give Mountain Brook Schools?



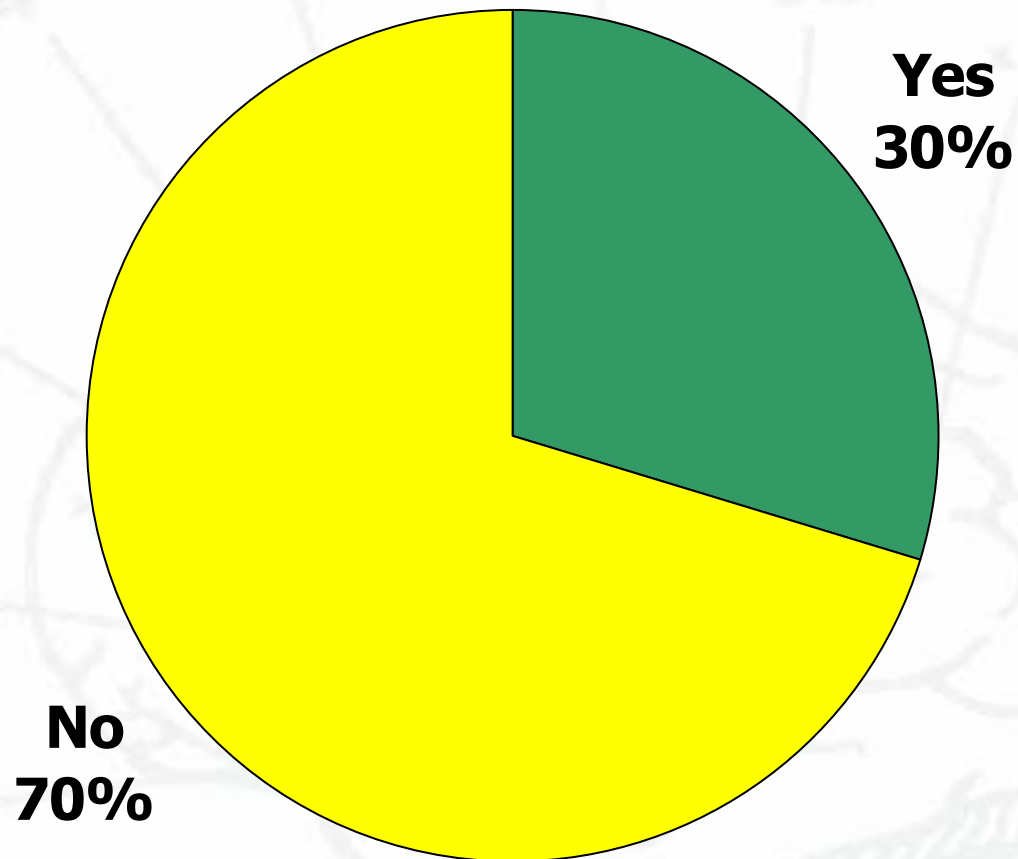


What are the demographics of the overall sample?

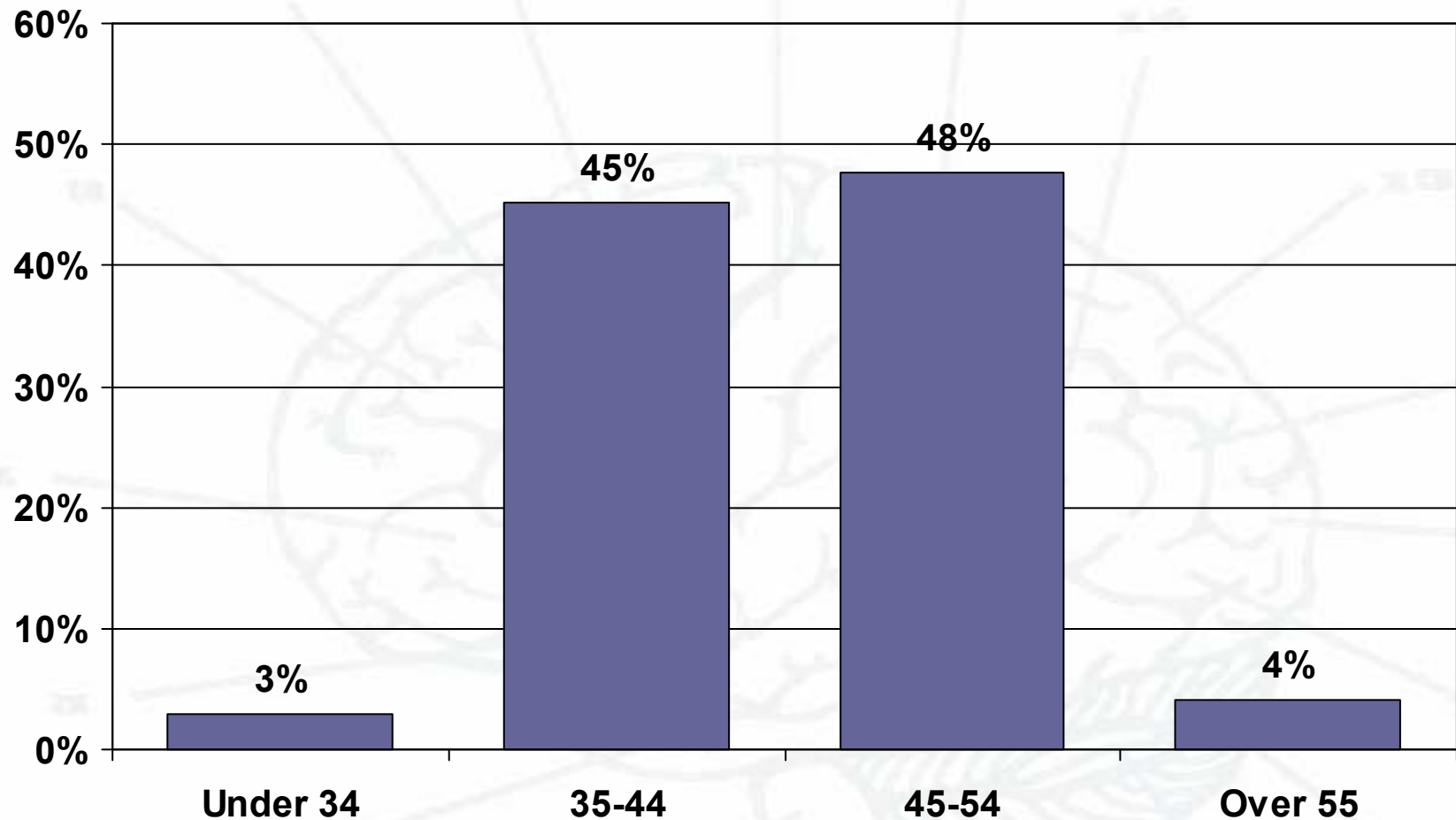
## In which grade is your child enrolled?



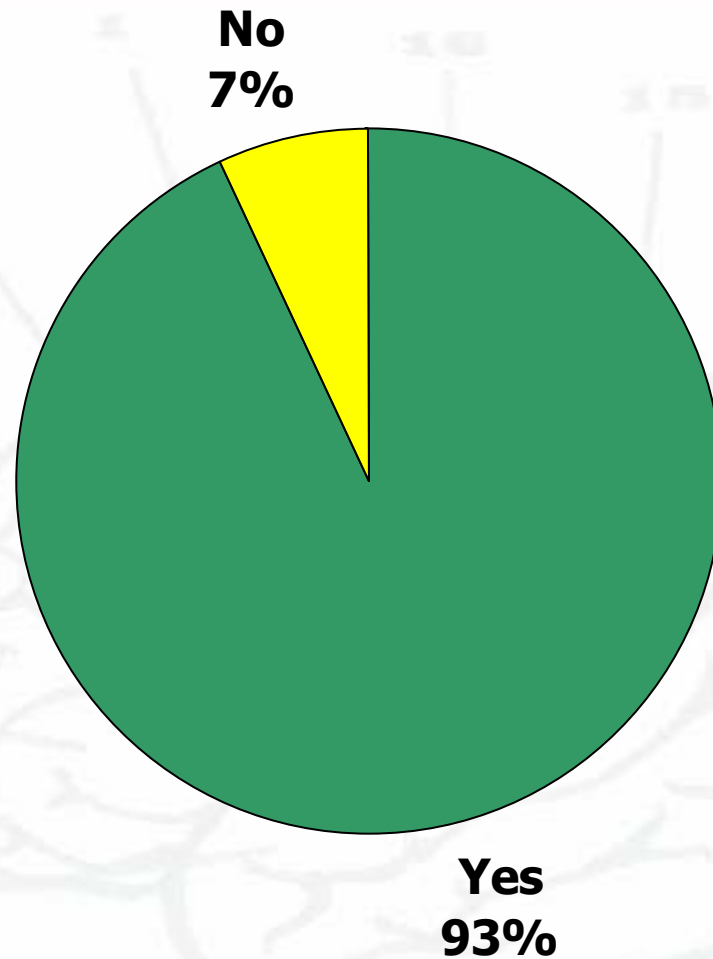
