Good afternoon, CBS Parents,

We know that many of you have inquired about picking up a Chromebook for your child during the school closure. After conversing with each of the elementary school principals, we have decided to create such an opportunity on Saturday, March 21.

It will be the first of multiple Chromebook distribution dates, so please don't worry if you can't make it to your school. We will work to ensure that all families have a chance to pick up their student's device in the coming weeks.

This Saturday, we will distribute Chromebooks by grade level via the **main carpool line**. In order to practice social distancing, we are asking that all families refrain from walking and remain in your car at all times. Below is the schedule:

- PreK-2: 8-9 a.m.
- 3-4: 9-10 a.m.
- 5-6: 10-11 a.m.

Families with multiple students across grade levels should come at the designated time of their youngest child. We will process your whole family's pickup in one trip. Once you arrive, we will ask you to tell us your student's name and homeroom so that we can locate the appropriate Chromebook and charger to deliver to your vehicle. Curbside service will be provided.
