## **Traditional Advancement Summer School**

### Program Attendance and Completion

- Students should be in attendance each day class is scheduled \*See schedule for class day dates.
- All rules and regulations listed in the student handbook apply to summer school. Students failing to adhere to behavior guidelines may be dismissed from the summer school program.
- The grading scale applies to traditional summer school.

## **Traditional Recovery and Credit Recovery Summer School**

### Program Attendance and Completion

Students failing to master the required standards in core academic classes have the opportunity to attend Summer School to recover that credit. There are two types of grade recovery Summer School: traditional and credit recovery. This program is only for 9<sup>th</sup> grade students who did not pass any 9<sup>th</sup> grade course. The program is a self-paced online format, along with live instruction and support. When students complete the program and demonstrate mastery in the assigned area, they will receive high school credit. Because the program is self-paced, some students may finish before the end of a term, while others may need to attend more than one term. In the traditional recovery program students will complete all components of the course and will receive the grade they earn from 0 to 100. In the credit recovery program students will take an assessment before completing the course content, if the student passes the assessment with a 70 or better, the student can move to the next assessments. Students will only have to complete components of the course if they did not pass the assessment with a 70 or above. The highest-grade students can receive for the course in the credit recovery program would be a 70.

- Students must be in attendance each day throughout their self-paced online format.
- All rules and regulations listed in the student handbook apply to Summer School. Students failing to adhere to behavior guidelines may be dismissed from the Summer School program.
- Per state guidelines, the credit recovery program grades for 9<sup>th</sup> grade courses cannot exceed a 70. **(All athletes need to take traditional summer school)**
- The traditional recovery program grades for 9<sup>th</sup> grade courses can be the score they earn from 0-100
- All course work must be completed no later than July 16<sup>th</sup>.

(Alg I, Geometry, Biology, English, History, and or World Language)

## Traditional Advancement Summer School

(CPA, CPB, and Health) Must have completed 7<sup>th</sup> grade to take CPA and must have completed 8<sup>th</sup> grade to take CPB/Health
