Responsibility Log:

If students are not following their responsibilities, they will be redirected and receive a verbal warning. If the behavior continues, they will complete the responsibility log (digitally) and parents will be notified via email. If they complete the responsibility log three times, they will participate in Classroom Detention.

Classroom detention will be offered on Wednesdays at 7:00-7:40 a.m. and 2:50-3:30 p.m. (student can choose which to attend), and will be done on the 6th grade hall. This will be a time to focus and reflect on behavior, and what it means to be Cougar STRONG. Students will bring reflection home for parent signature and will be returned the *following* day. If students do not complete their reflections in the time allowed in detention, the work will be completed at recess. If a student arrives later than 7:05 am or 2:55 pm, then an additional detention will be required.

- 3rd offense – Responsibility Log and Classroom Detention (Wednesdays 7:00 – 7:40 am or 2:50 – 3:30 pm)
- 4th offense – Responsibility Log / Parent emailed
- 5th offense – Responsibility Log / Parent emailed
- 6th offense - Responsibility Log and Classroom Detention (Wednesdays 7:00 – 7:40 am or 2:50 – 3:30 pm)
- 7th offense – Office Referral
