

Dear Parents,

In order to guarantee your child, and all the children, the excellent learning environment they deserve, I am utilizing the following management plan. During the first week of school, the children will learn these classroom rules.

Classroom Rules:

1. Listen and follow directions.
2. Use a soft voice in the classroom.
3. Use hands to help and not hurt.
4. Use kind words and be a good friend.
5. Walk in school to be safe.

Consequences for misbehavior:

Children begin each day with a rainbow tower of 5 color cubes. I will give one reminder for the desired behavior. If the child continues, he/she must take the top cube off his/her rainbow tower and bring it to the teacher. Immediate and natural consequences are often the best for young children. If disrupting the group, the child sits away from the class. If too rough on the playground, the child will sit out for a time. At the end of each day, the child will record the top cube color on the Behavior Log in the take-home folder. If needed, I will date and write a brief explanation of what happened. Please follow up at home to reinforce our class rules and reward good behavior.

1st consequence – verbal reminder

2nd consequence – give BLUE cube to teacher, receive a consequence

3rd consequence – give Green cube to teacher, a longer consequence and a note goes home on Behavior Log

4th consequence – give YELLOW cube to teacher, parent is contacted by e-mail or phone

5th consequence – give ORANGE cube to teacher, the child and teacher will go to see an administrator; parent conference will be arranged

We will be working together this year to monitor your child’s classroom behavior. Please go over the rules and the consequences with your child so s/he knows we are all focusing on the same set of rules. Together, parents and students sign the tear-off portion below and return the lower portion tomorrow. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to write me a note or ask at Parent Night. I appreciate your cooperation.
