AIMB Student Liaison

There will be 2 student representatives (boy and girl) elected by the student body from each grade 9-12, with the 12th grade representatives serving as ex-officio members of the All In Mountain Brook Board.

These representatives will:

- 1. Generate ideas and suggestions for student programming and activities surrounding mental health issues, drugs, alcohol, technology, personal safety, etc.**
- 2. Market scheduled programming to peers and community.**
- 3. Assist with on-campus and community programming on the day/evening of the events.**

* The reps will meet several times in late spring and early summer to develop programming plans for the upcoming school year. Their input will be invaluable in determining types of speakers, developing online programming, utilizing social media as a marketing tool, etc. They will meet with the PTO, AIMB reps, and the principal to formulate the overall school plan.

* The reps will be asked to assist with any programming throughout the school year that is planned by AIMB. They would not have to be at each event, but should try to make as many events as possible.

* The 2 senior reps would attend the programming brainstorming session in early May, and would be the spokespeople for the other reps at the Board level. These senior reps would be invited to each Board meeting.
