

MBHS SUMMER READING PROGRAM: 2022-2023

THIS INFORMATION MAY BE PRINTED FROM THE MOUNTAIN BROOK HIGH SCHOOL WEBSITE:
The summer reading program is intended to introduce students to a variety of reading materials. These works should both supplement and enhance the literary works covered within the school year curriculum as well as help foster a love of reading. **Students should not choose books they have read previously for choice texts.**

- Those students who will be in **College Prep English** (formerly labeled “Regular”) courses are required to read the following books designated by grade level:

10th GRADE: (2 books) **two required works of fiction**

11th GRADE: (2 books) **two required works of fiction**

12th GRADE: (2 books) **two required works of fiction**

- **Advanced, AP, and Dual Enrollment** classes have separate lists and special instructions.

All books and accompanying assignments should be completed by **the first day of school in August**. Students should be prepared for class discussion, written analysis, and/or other evaluation the first few days of school.

Students may not work collaboratively on summer reading assignments unless the instructors specifically say to do so in the instructions. Likewise, it is understood that students will not use any reading aids in lieu of reading actual works.
